

Implications of the Resurrection #4 Suffering and Sinning

Text: 1 Corinthians 15:29-34

It makes a huge difference to the way we live our lives whether this life is the **destination** or the **departure lounge**.

1. **Suffering for the Kingdom**
2. **Sinning**

But...what about verse 29?

Back to the main points...

1. Suffering for the Kingdom...makes sense

See verses 30-32...

Many have taken this seriously – e.g. Adoniram Judson

What about us?

2. Sinning...must stop!

Paul now confronts the Corinthians – verses 33-34

It is easy for us in lockdown to think it doesn't matter if we indulge in sinful behaviour.

So, we might seek to escape from reality. How?

2 common ways are through getting drunk and pornography.

Paul says in v34 – 'come back to your senses'

So, are there things you need to stop doing?
